



Visiting Scholars @ S. Horowitz Institute for Intellectual Property at Tel-Aviv University

The S. Horowitz Institute for Intellectual Property in Memory of Dr. Amnon Goldenberg at TAU Law invites visiting scholars to spend up to one month at the Institute.

Eligible applicants are doctoral students in their last year, or within three years after receiving their doctoral degree, who are not yet employed at any academic institute and devote most of his or her time to research.

The fellowship consists of a one-time grant of up to U.S. \$2500, towards a research visit to the Institute @ TAU Law Faculty. The fellow may use the grant to cover flights, accommodation and research costs. The Institute cannot cover these costs independently of the fellowship.

During the visit at TAU Law, the fellow will have full access to library services; is welcome to attend courses and workshops at TAU Law, and participate in the Institute's and Faculty conferences.

The application should be submitted via email only, to shiip@tau.ac.il, and follow the detailed instructions which are available at the Institute's website <http://en-law.tau.ac.il/shiip>.

Applications are considered on a rolling basis.
