Registration of Trademarks.

WHEREAS the Ottoman Laws of 28th April 1304 and 10th March 1296 provide for the registration and the protection of trademarks, patents and designs.

that any person who is the proprietor of a trademark, patent or design already granted in the Ottoman Empire or abroad may provisionally register such trademark, patent or design in O. E. T. A. (S) by lodging in the Office of the Court of Appeal at Jerusalem a sworn declaration that the grant has previously been

made together with a sketch in duplicate of the trademark, patent or design.

The fees provided in the said Ottoman Laws as well as those prescribed by the Stamp Law of February 6th. 1321, will be payable.

PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE NO. 2

A. Regulations for Reinterment of Dead Bodies.

- 1. Application to reinter a corpse must be made in writing to the P. H. D. stating both the present burial place and the proposed place reinterment.
- 2. The application must be endorsed by the burial authority of the proposed place of reinterment.
- 3. Evidence of the cause of death must be produced, either by a regular medical certificate or by such other evidence as may be considered satisfactory by the Public Health Department. The name age, nationality and occupation of

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
