## Trade Mark Ordinance, 1940 - Classes

The following is the classification of trademarks according to the British law in place in Mandate Palestine, in effect as of 1940, replacing the Trade Marks Ordinance, 1921 classification.
The right column presents our categorization of the classes, so to create a common denominator with the newer classification.
