# Invited presentations to internationally established conferences and information on publications

Only in the last decade I gave about 120 talks at academic conferences in all continents. I was invited to give seminars at many institutions. My articles were published in leading journals internationally and in books published by leading publishers (altogether over 60 articles and chapters). My books (both monograph and edited) were published by Cambridge University Press. An interview about my work in queer theory was published in a special issue of the journal Critical Analysis of Law devoted to Queer Legal Theory. Symposia on my book, The Writing on the Wall: Rethinking the International Law of Occupations were published in the *London Review of International Law* and in the leading international law blog *Opinio Juris*.
