### ***Invited presentations to internationally established conferences and information on publications***

Only in the last decade I gave about 120 talks at academic conferences in all continents. I was invited to give seminars at many institutions. My articles were published in leading journals internationally and in books published by leading publishers (altogether over 60 articles and chapters). My books (both monograph and edited) were published by Cambridge University Press. An interview about my work in queer theory was published in a special issue of the journal *Critical Analysis of Law* devoted to Queer Legal Theory. Symposia on my book, *The Writing on the Wall: Rethinking the International Law of Occupations* were published in the *London Review of International Law* and in the leading international law blog *Opinio Juris*. It was reviewed in leading journals such as the *American Journal of International Law* and the *British Yearbook of International Law*.

Book symposia were held in 12 locations (European University Institute in Florence, Harvard, Colombia, National University Singapore, SOAS University of London, King's College London and University of Manchester in the UK, Ljubljana University in Slovenia, Science-Po in Paris, and in Israel at Tel Aviv University, Haifa University, and the Hebrew University of Jerusalem). I published in leading legal blogs including the constitutional law blogs *Verfassungsblog* and the IACL-AIDC [International Association of Constitutional Law] Blog and the international law blogs *Opinio Juris* and *Just Security*. I published posts and edited symposia in the ICON-S-IL Blog (Blog of the Israeli Chapter of ICON-S).
